Maker Space & Art Workshop

During the program, students will have the opportunity to use our creative maker space. Within this space, students can build and operate robots and design and create using our 3-D printers. Students will also have the option of taking part in a visual art workshop where they will paint and draw. Fun weekly themes will help to inspire the students.



English Workshop

The English Workshop will focus on written expression and reading comprehension. Our students will take part in small group discussions about note-taking skills and outlining written assignments. This workshop will be offered at two different skill levels based on an evaluation at the start of the program. The goal is for our students to have more confidence in their English-speaking abilities before school starts.

APPLICATION & AGREEMENT FORMS

New and returning Worcester Academy students are automatically accepted into the Summer Program. Please submit the completed Worcester Academy Summer Program Agreement form and summer tuition payment with your regular session school documents.

SUMMER PROGRAM TUITION

- \$4,900(USD) per student
- Tuition includes: program, housing, meals, day trips, books, and related material costs – other purchases are the student's responsibility.

DEADLINES

The application, agreement, and tuition are due April 10. Rolling admission begins after April 10 as space allows.

Math Workshop

This workshop will focus on problem solving as students explore topics from algebra, geometry, and data analysis. Mathematical vocabulary and proper notation will be emphasized. Students will learn how to make their reasoning visible to others, both by showing their work and explaining how they solve problems. The workshop will take place in small groups so that students have support from our faculty along with other students. Students will start the school year as more confident problem solvers.
